GIFT AID DECLARATION

How Gift Aid works

If you pay tax, Gift Aid is a scheme by which you can give a sum of money to a charity and the charity can reclaim from Inland Revenue basic rate tax on your gift. This increases the value of your gift to the charity. For example, if you give £15 using Gift Aid in the 2009/2010 tax year, that Gift is worth £18.75 to the charity, or 25% more than without Gift Aid. Subject to a few rules, you can give any amount, large or small, regular or one-off.

If you are a higher rate tax payer, you can claim relief on the difference between the basic and higher rates of tax.

If you are not a tax payer, you should **not** use Gift Aid. Companies may not use Gift Aid.
